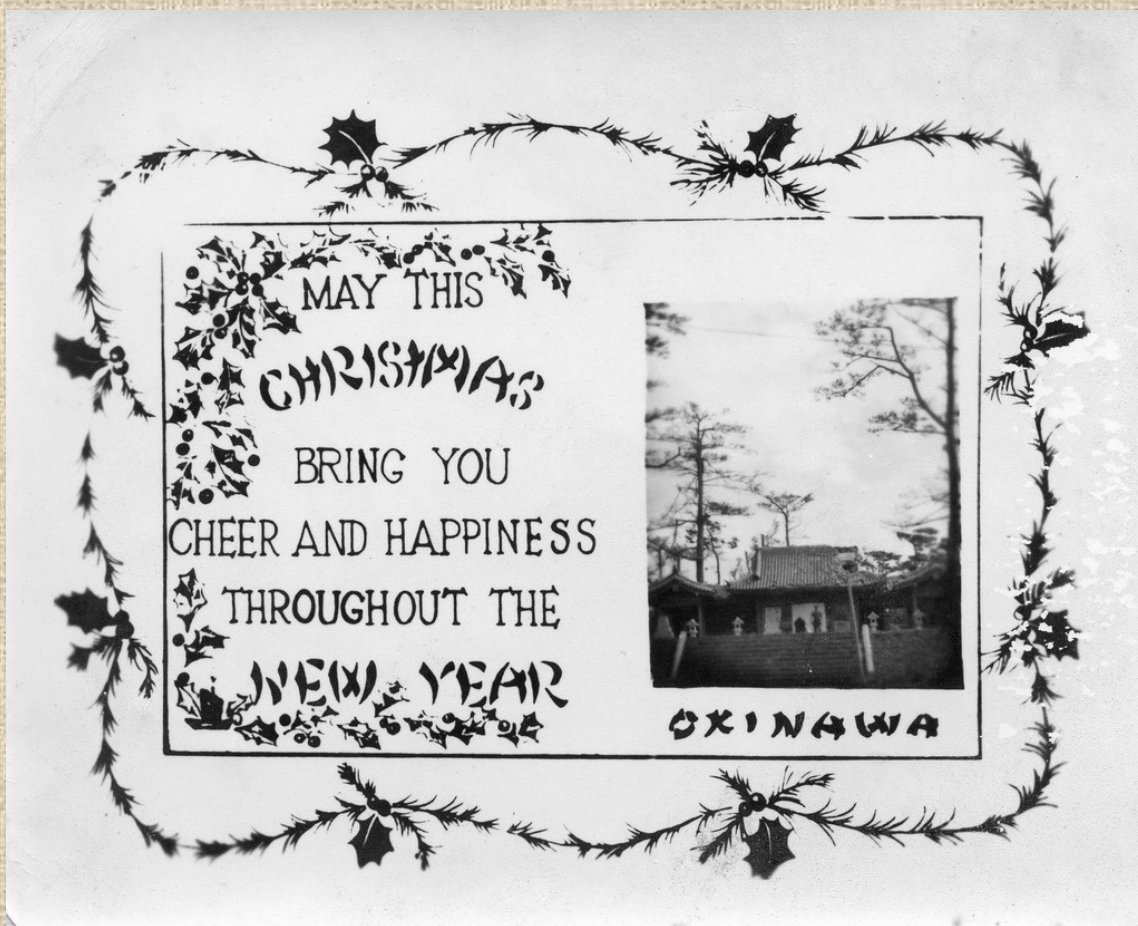




Ue Shima, up near the top, is where Enie Pyle is buried. It's a pretty small, flat island with one conical mountain on it.

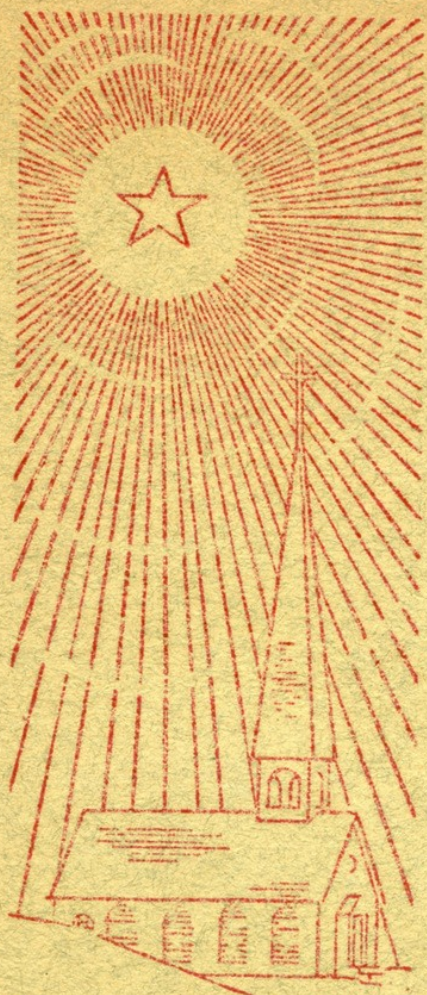

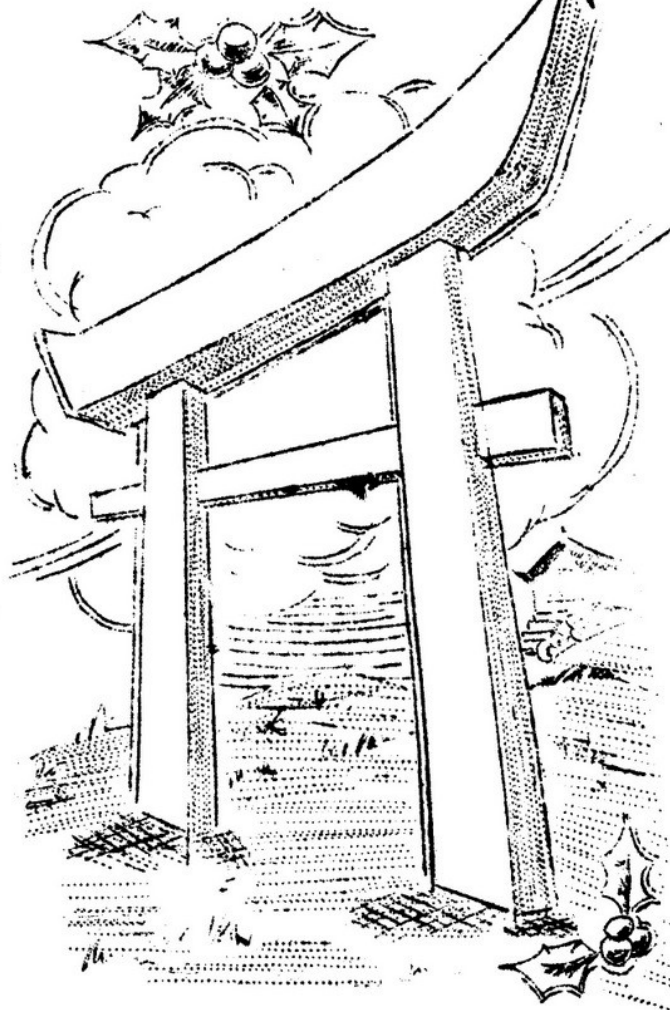

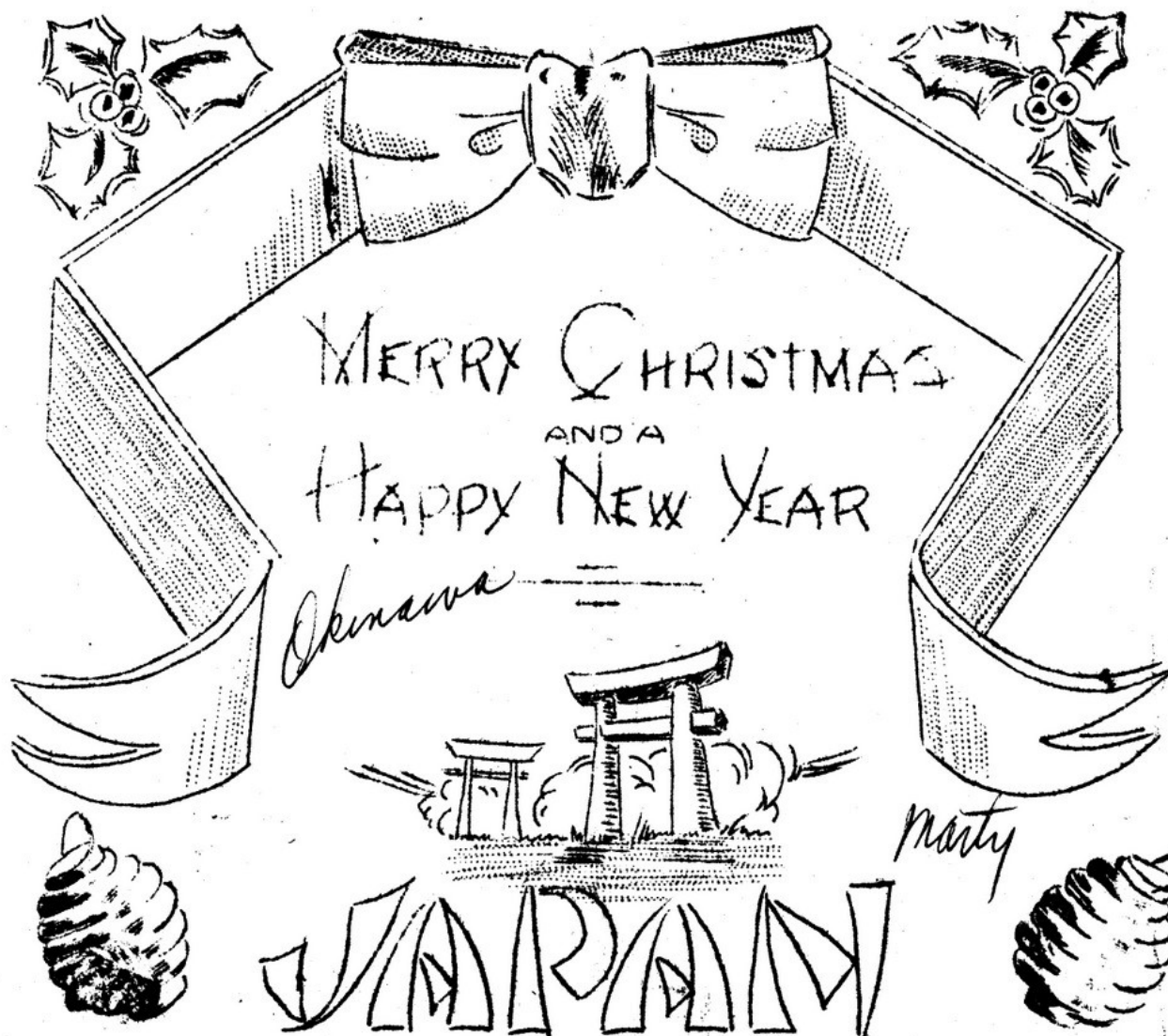
